

From the Principal's Desk

External School Review

As part of our continuous school improvement process, we will be involved in an external school review with a Department for Education review panel.

The purpose of an external school review is to support us to raise achievement, sustain high performance and provide quality assurance to build public confidence in government schools.

All government schools are externally reviewed every 3 years.

The focus of the external school review is to evaluate our school's performance. The review panel includes a review officer and a trained review principal. ***Our school review will occur on Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th of September (Week 9).***

The review panel will identify aspects of our school's improvement that have been verified through the review processes, as well as the improvements that we need to make in the future.

During the external school review, some students, parents, governing council members and staff will be asked to provide information to the review panel in a number of ways. These include:

- individual interviews
- group discussions (with students or staff or parents)
- meetings (governing council, staff meeting)
- visits into classrooms.

The ESR process will work with the Principal to ensure it will be adhering to the current advice from the SA Health and DfE guidelines regarding COVID-19.

We appreciate everyone's support and time in helping us with this external school review process. Please notify the Front Office on 88 262 060 if you **do not** want your child to participate in a group discussion.

All parents/caregivers are invited to attend a group discussion on THURSDAY, 16th at 8:45am-9:30am.

Pupil Free Day & School Closure


Father's Day








Warner Bros Serverspace
The Warner Bros Serverspace is where everything from Looney Tunes is kept. There are different realities where the Looney Tune characters are kept. It feels like being inside a computer game.


