
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From the Principal's Desk

Preparing for a bushfire

Our School/Early Learning Centre has detailed plans in place to keep your child(ren) safe on catastrophic fire days or in the event of a bushfire.

- making a bushfire survival plan with your family
- providing us with your up-to-date contact details
- advising the school/preschool if your family's personal bushfire survival plan will impact school attendance
- talking to your child about what will happen in a bushfire emergency

- adding the emergency information hotline 1800 000 279 to your contacts.

Parents and caregivers should also read the attached **bushfire and your child's school or** preschool brochure. As our site is considered a high risk site (R2) this resource explains what our site will do on a catastrophic fire day or in the event of a fire.






We have been exploring our numeracy focus of shape this term. We read the story "Shapes" by Roald Dahl. As we read the story we had discussions and language such as edges, corners, curved, straight and round to describe differences between the shapes. Then we used our shape magnifying glasses to be shape detectives and find the shapes in our environment. We noticed that there are so many shapes all around us! Children have also enjoyed using a variety of different shapes to inspire some creative collages.


