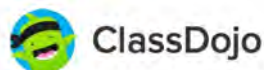

Upper Primary Rotational Symmetry

In the Upper Primary class, we have been learning about rotational symmetry. A shape has Rotational Symmetry when it still looks the same after some rotation (of less than one full turn).

How many times it can be turned to look the same as we go once around is called the **Order**.

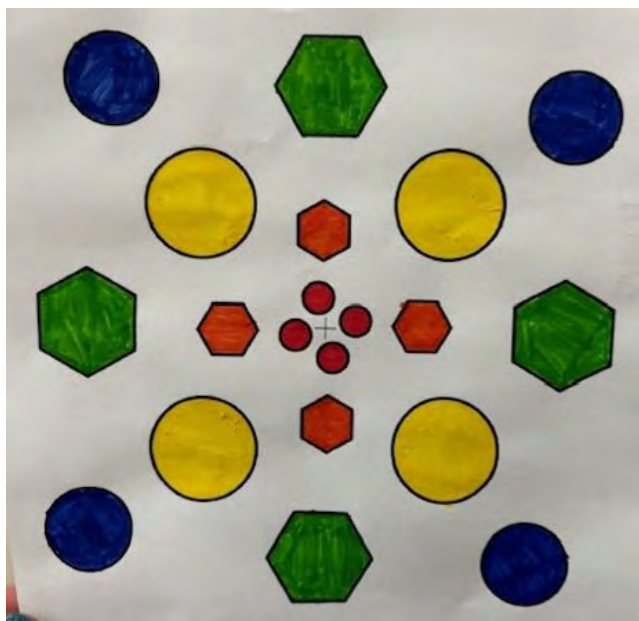
Is there Rotational Symmetry of Order 1?

Not really! If a shape only matches itself **once** as we go around (ie it matches itself after one full rotation) there is really no symmetry at all ...

... because the word "Symmetry" comes from *syn- together* and *metron measure*, and there can't be "together" if there is just one thing.

We experimented with a symmetry art website to create some rotational symmetry designs. Then we had to colour them in, making sure we chose colours carefully so we didn't change the symmetry of the design.

The Middle Primary joined us for this lesson and here are some of our completed designs.



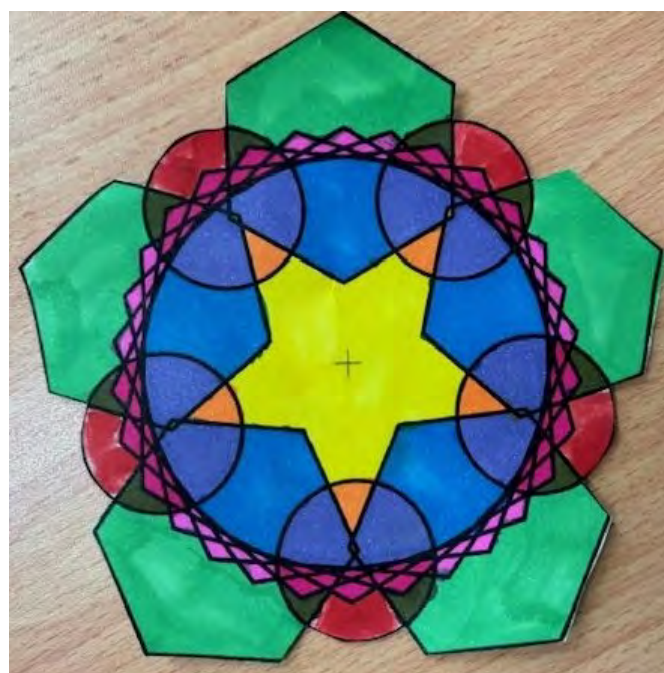

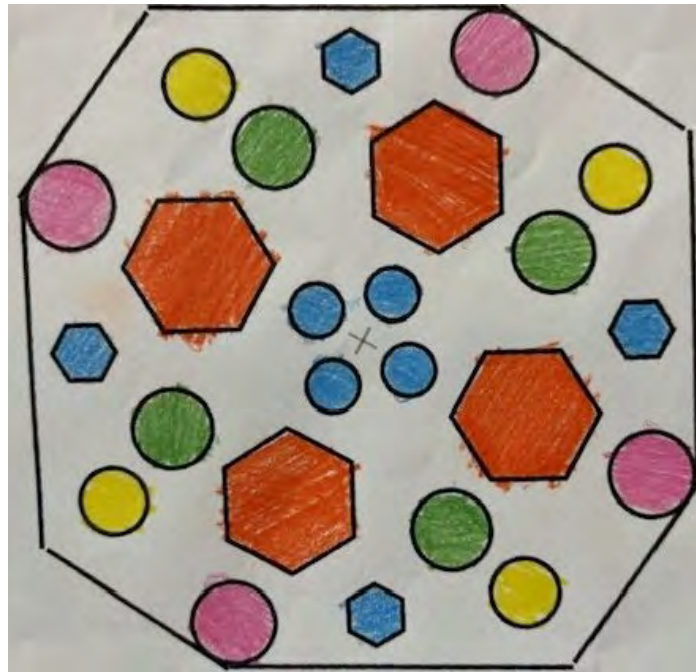
